It has been ranked by Business Week as one of the best places in the U.S. to raise children and offers many cultural and recreational options.

Wilmette also offers public, private and religious school options. At the conclusion of fourth grade, students from Central, Harper, McKenzie and Romona schools attend Highcrest Middle School for 5th and 6th grades and then matriculate to Wilmette Junior High School. Those students attending Avoca Elementary matriculate to Marie Murphy school (6-8.) All Wilmette 8th graders attend the freshman campus of New Trier High School and then to the east campus in Winnetka.

Residents of Winnetka have public, private and religious school options within and nearby the community.
